At approx. 0147 12/24/18 Yakima County Sheriff's Deputies were dispatched to a local area hospital re two gunshot victims. The victims, a 27 year old Hispanic male who resides in Sunnyside and a 20 year old Caucasian female who resides in the Toppenish area, alleged they had been southbound in the 4500 block of the Sunnyside Mabton Hwy when they were cut off by another vehicle. A male then exited the other vehicle and began to shoot at the victims.

The both victims suffered gunshot wounds but they were able to drive themselves to the hospital. The femaless wounds were not life threatening. The male's condition was listed as serious.

No arrests have been made at this time but the investigation continues.
