Location: 050 block of Egan Lane Wapato, Washington

Incident Date and Time: February 12, 2019 at 2100 hours

At 2100 hours on February 12, 2019 an individual called 911 to report a gun battle between people in two separate vehicles. This was reported to have occurred at the intersection of Egan Lane and North Track Road, just outside the City of Wapato.

Three minutes later several 911 calls were placed from the immediate area of the Roadrunner Gas Station/Market at 705 West First Street in the City of Wapato. Yakima County Sheriff's Office Deputies and Yakama Tribal Police personnel responded immediately for the report of two gunshot victims in the parking lot.

Two gunshot victims were located and taken to a local hospital for treatment of their wounds related to the shooting. A third person ran from the vehicle. That third person was not located.

The first victim was a 37-year-old female from Selah. The second, a 37-year-old male from the Wapato area.

Evidence from both locations was secured as a part of this investigation.

Follow-up investigation for this incident will be conducted by the Yakima County Sheriff's Office Detective Division.
