



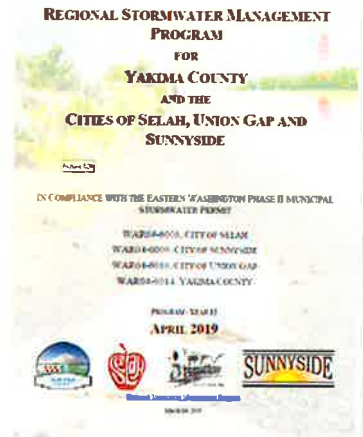

Eastern Washington Phase II Municipal Stormwater Annual Report

March is the month when all permittees of the Department of Ecology's Phase II Municipal Stormwater Permit are required to complete their Stormwater Management Program Plans (SWMP) and submit their Annual Reports to Ecology for the previous calendar year. For our RSWG, each permittee is required to submit their individual Annual Report directly to Ecology while the group is allowed to prepare one SWMP covering all the jurisdictions in the working group. The Annual Report and the SWMP provide a written summary to the general public and Ecology about the stormwater management programs that were developed and/or carried out by the permittees over the previous year.
